SECTION 4 FIRST AID MEASURES

FIRST AID - EYE CONTACT:

SECTION 5 FIREFIGHTING MEASURE

Extinguishing media

Use dry chemical powder and sand.

Special protection procedures

Unusual fire or explosion hazards

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SECTION 6 ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Environmental precautions:

Clean-up methods:

Clean up spills immediately, observing precautions in the Protective Equipment section. Remove all sources of ignition. Use a spark-proof tool. A vapor suppressing foam may be used to reduce vapors.

Storage: For safe storage, store between -20 °C (-4°F) and 40 °C (104°F) .Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area.
